

Upcoming Changes to the State Health Plan

Changes effective 1/1/2018

State Health Plan

Board of Trustees Decisions

- Eliminate the Consumer Directed Health Plan (CDHP) -2018
 - HRA Implications for 2017
- Eliminate the Primary Care Physician wellness activity/premium credit in 2018
- Eliminate the Health Assessment wellness activity/premium credit in 2018
- Keep the Tobacco Attestation wellness activity/premium credit- \$60 in 2018

Impact to State Health Plan Premiums (2018)

- 70/30, Employee-Only: \$25/month or \$85/month (w/ \$60 tobacco surcharge)
- 80/20, Employee-Only: \$50/month or \$110/month (w/ \$60 tobacco surcharge)

Impact to State Health Plan Premiums (2018)

- Freeze Family Tier premiums through 2021
- Spouse premium increases 6.96% for 2018 and then freezes through 2021
- Child(ren) premium increases 6.96% for 2018 and then freezes through 2021
